Footnotes

PAPA TIME was unhurried early, advanced steadily in the third turn, rallied in the upper stretch and closed steadily. SARATOGA AVENUE broke sharply, dueled to the inside of TIGERHEAT, opened a lead in the third turn, rallied in the upper stretch but weakened to finish second best. BALLINTOY stalked the leaders on the rail, raced evenly but flattened out in the stretch. WORKING MAN BLUES stalked the pace to the outside but weakened after the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. VALDERO saved ground, raced evenly and was no factor. TIGERHEAT dueled to the outside of SARATOGA AVENUE but weakened entering the third turn and dropped back steadily.
